

NZPIA Exam Guide

New Zealand Parachute Industry Association Rules

Should you be required to sit a NZPIA Exam at this Operation the following regulations are required to be followed:

3.03.01

PREREQUISITES & GRADES

a) Pass marks required are as follows:

1) Multi Choice	70%	3) Written	70%
2) Practical	70%	4) Oral	70%

- b) **The candidate's examination papers will be marked by the CSO/Instructor Examiner whoever is applicable and forwarded to the NZPIA.**
- c) **Practical Requirements:** All candidates prior to registration must produce proof of having filled the practical requirements for the subject being examined.
- d) All examinations will consist of the appropriate parts written, oral or practical, or any combination of these approved by the Safety Director.
- e) The pass requirement will be, as specified in **3.03.01(a)**, failure of any part will be deemed a failure for the whole examination.

INTEGRITY OF EXAMINATIONS

- a) Written examinations are to be conducted in such a way as to ensure their integrity and minimise the opportunity for cheating.
- b) Where more than one candidate is being examined at the same time, they are to be provided with separate desks or tables or otherwise screened from each other so they are not able to refer to each other's papers.
- c) Where the examination is 'closed book', the walls of the room are to be checked to ensure that there is no material attached to them that could aid the candidate.
- d) The candidate(s) are to be supervised for the duration of the examination to ensure that they do not refer to any unauthorised source of information or communicate with any other person.
- e) The candidate shall provide proof of identity before any examination.
- f) The person administering the examination is to sign his or her name on the script after grading it and the script is to be retained in the NZPIA registered office.

CHEATING OR UNAUTHORISED CONDUCT

- a) Attention is drawn to the provisions of **CAR Part 61.19**. Any candidate performing any act specified in this section will be failed the examination and may be dismissed or incur other disciplinary action.
