### **`B' CERTIFICATE (FREEFALL PARACHUTIST)**

- a) The freefall parachutist must have successfully completed training in the performance of freefall jumps under the direct supervision of a suitably qualified Parachute Instructor and is qualified to jump independently from an Instructor.
- b) Attainment of this certificate indicates a level of knowledge and experience to take part in all forms of parachuting.
- c) Conditions - Applicants must:
  - 1) Fulfil the conditions of Certificate `A'.
  - 2) Have made 50 free fall parachute descents and accumulated a minimum of 30 minutes of free fall time.
  - 3) Have completed a minimum of 10 formation jumps of which 5 must involve a minimum of three participants.
  - 4) Have landed within 5 metres of a designated landing point on five occasions.
  - 5) Have determined the correct exit point and exited the aircraft at that point without assistance, landing within 30 metres of the chosen landing point.
  - 6) Have attended and passed a High Altitude Course.
  - 7) Be approved a 'Fit and Proper person'.
- d) Qualification – NZPIA issues an 'B' Certificate
