To: All NZPIA certificate holders
Subject: Privileges/responsibilities of NZPIA certificates and ratings

As a result of a recent incident, this Safety Notice is being issued to remind all certificate and rating holders that the duties and responsibilities of their NZPIA documents apply at all times.

All parachutists, whether at work or at play, jumping commercially under Part 115 or recreationally as a “sport jumper,” are required to comply with the relevant Civil Aviation Rules and NZPIA standards and procedures.

All parachutists have a responsibility to know the rules and act in accordance with them. They are also expected to act safely and not expose themselves or others to excessive risk. Disregarding this could result in the revocation of the parachutist certificate and/or rating.
